Crop Walk participants raise money by asking people to sponsor them for the walk- 10 kilometers (6.2 miles). This distance represents the average distance walked by millions of women and children all over the globe to get water for their daily needs. The money raised is used to help hungry neighbors around the block and around the world. The money collected is also used for long-term development and disaster relief programs through Church World Services.

In addition to raising money, we ask all participants to bring a jar of peanut butter, box of rice, or a can of beans for the local food pantries in the area.
