## REMINDERS

Spring Uniforms – All boys and girls in grades 5 through 7 and  $8^{th}$  graders no longer must wear the school sweater or senior fleece daily. However, during the early spring, the mornings can be chilly. If a sweater is needed in school, it must be the school sweater. Boys may wear the khaki shorts.

*School Shoes* – Lately some of our older girls have taken to wearing moccasin shoes that have a lace running along the side and ending in a bow on the top of the school. This is not the uniform shoe. The uniform shoe is to be an oxford type shoe with several eyelets for lacing (buck or similar style), not a slip on shoe.
