Choose one project for each book:

1. Write a letter to the main character of your book.
  - Include all elements of a friendly letter
  - Include questions, complaints, suggestions or opinions.
2. Make a 10 question test about the book you read.
  - Use information from the book to create a test that you could give to other readers to check their understanding of the story.
  - The test could include matching, multiple choice or fill in the blank questions. Don't forget the answer key.
3. Create your own bookmark.
  - On one side illustrate an important scene from the story, the title and author.
  - The other side should include a 5-8 sentence summary about the book.
4. Design and make your own t-shirt.
  - Illustrate a scene or character from the book on a t-shirt. (Use an old, used or new shirt)
  - Write a short summary of the scene or a description of the character and explain why either is important in the story.
