Students Entering Grade 4 in September 2025 - Reading List

All students are to read 2 grade level chapter books over the summer. The first book is required reading for all students. For the second book, students may choose from the additional 2 books listed below. The required reading of **Frindle** will be graded with a book test. The other book will be represented by the completion of one project chosen from the list below.

***<u>Required book</u>**- students must read <u>Frindle</u> written by Andrew Clements. Take chapter notes and be prepared for a book test by the end of the first week of school.

*Second book- students choose one of the following books and complete one of the projects listed below. Choose between <u>Tales of a Fourth Grade Nothing</u> by Judy Blume or <u>James and the Giant Peach</u> by Roald Dahl.

Choose one of these projects for your second book choice:

- 1. <u>Cereal Box Book Report</u>- Students will use an empty cereal box and the worksheets attached to create their own book report.
- 2. <u>Slide Show</u>- Students will create a Google Slideshow consisting of at least 6 slides using clip art, font of choice, and descriptive writing to include:

Slide #1: Title of book, author, student nameSlide #2: Setting, plot, time, list of charactersSlides #3-5: Summaries of the beginning, middle, and end of the storySlide #6: Opinion of book, recommended reading audience
