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Practice writing your first name using an uppercase letter for the first letter and lowercase for the rest.	Go for a walk. See how many shapes you can find along the way!	Retell the story of one of your favorite books to someone younger than you.	What words rhyme with cat? See how many you can find!	Walk around your house and see how many numbers you can find and identify.
Play a board game like Chutes and Ladders or Candy Land.	Write the letters of the alphabet outside in chalk.	Practice writing your last name using an uppercase letter for the first letter and lowercase for the rest.	Cut out words you know from magazines and newspapers.	Count to 20 while doing jumping jacks.
List the people in your family.	Tell a friend your birthdate.	Help a grown up sort the clean laundry.	Color a picture for someone you love. Try to color neatly and in the lines.	Tell your address to a family member.
Practice your phone number with a grown up.	Count 20 coins.	Count the steps from your front door to your bedroom.	Practice tying your shoes.	Make a craft using a glue stick.
Write the letters of the alphabet in sand at the beach.	Practice putting your coat on and off on your own.	How many words can you identify as you ride in a car?	Read a book from the Summer Reading List. See how many letter sounds or words you can identify.	Pack a lunch in a lunchbox. See if you can open everything on your own!
