### NO PLUNGING REQUIRED TO JOIN US!

All event costs and insurance are handled by the AOH. Saint James keeps 100% of the money we raise. It's the best fundraiser out there! Polar Plunge also qualifies for corporate charitable gift matching programs. Please contact the PTA for more information.

All Polar Plungers may register in advance or on the day of the event. However, we strongly recommend registering in advance, as registration at the event can be difficult due to the large crowd. Participants are required to raise a minimum of \$50 to register --this may be paid directly by the participant or they may receive sponsorship from others to cover the registration fee. But \$50 is only the minimum; there's no maximum to how much any individual can raise!
